You are encouraged to submit a poster for presentation. The guidelines are:

1. A poster presentation submission should have a title page with a 250-word abstract, but not the authors' names. Upon submission, you must select the FBD Member Organization (listed below) that is most closely related to your poster. Poster submissions will be double-blind reviewed. Submission of the actual poster is not required at this time.
2. A poster presentation should be original and not presented elsewhere or be a summary of a published paper. At least one author for each accepted poster presentation will be expected to register for the conference and personally appear to present the poster.
3. If accepted, you will be expected to prepare a poster up to 45" in width & 45" in length.
